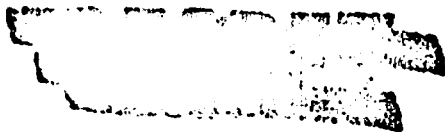


Month of February, 1944. Prepared by Capt. J. W. CLAGG

DAY	EVENTS
Feb. 1.	During this shortest month of the year, the Group made a new record of missions completed. (Numbering 12)
3	The 306th put up 40 A/C in two groups and 31 A/C attacked the port of Milhalschaven. "A" Group was led by Lt. Col. Lambert and "B" Group by Capt. Witt of the 367th Squadron. Bombing was through 10/10 cloud on PFF and later (W) photos confirmed good results. Car escort was excellent and no R/A were seen. Flak was moderate and inaccurate. Lt. Long of the 367th was lost, reason unknown.
4	Again the 306th put up two groups, totaling 39 A/C and 24 A/C attacked Frankfurt through 10/10 cloud on PFF. Leading "A" Group was Capt. Kelly. Leading "B" Group was Lt. Col. Buckley. No enemy fighters were seen but accurate A.A. gun fire along the route knocked down Lts. Berry and Bare of the 367th and crews. Lts. Ellerton, Hossley, O'Malley and Neokovitch were killed when their plane crashed in a 3 engine take-off at Dron Field, East Lothian, Scotland.
5	Twenty one A/C, led by Lt. H.H. Thompson, took off and bombed visually, with excellent results, the A/D at Chateaudun, France. Good fighter cover was provided and only enemy opposition was very accurate tracking A.A. fire at the target, which damaged 11 of our A/C. Several men of Lt. Sokal's crew, 423rd, sustained minor flak wounds. All of our A/C returned to base. Group Officers' Party was held in "A" Mess.
6	Twenty-eight A/C, led by Lt. Col. Lambert, took off to bomb Nancy-Essey A/D in France. Due to 10/10 cloud the target could not be identified and all bombs were returned to base. No enemy fighter opposition was met and flak was negligible.
8	Twenty A/C, led by Lt. Peterson, took off and bombed Frankfurt on PFF through 10/10 cloud with unobserved results. More than an hour after bombs away, during a slight gap in fighter cover, two F-190s came out of a cloud, from below, and swept through our formation, knocking out Lt. Snyder of the "Flightin Bitin. Some accurate tracking fire was encountered over the target and at St. Quentin, damaging 17 of our A/C. Our score for the day was 0-0-2.
21	Twenty-one A/C, led by Lt. H.H. Thompson, took off on a PFF mission to bomb Frankfurt. Due to failure of PFF equipment bombs were dropped visually by 20 A/C on a town identified as Roux. Fighter escort was excellent. A.A. Gunfire in the Saarbrücken area was moderate but extremely accurate, damaging 19 of our A/C. Lt. DiBette of the 423rd was seen landing when about 20 minutes from the French Coast and has not been heard from since.
20	Forty-one A/C, divided into two groups, took off to bomb the vital aero-works at Leipzig. "A" Group, led by Capt. Kirk of the 367th, failed to make rendezvous, so turned back at the enemy coast. Group "B", led by Lt. J.D. McManon, 306th, with 20 A/C, attacked the primary with excellent results as confirmed by strike photographs. Lt. Richard, of the 423rd was hit by flak over the target and twenty minutes later was attacked by fighters and went down under control. Our score for the day was 0-0-4.

DAY	EVENTS
Feb. 21	<p>Twenty-one A/C led by Lt. Col. Lambert, heading the 40th Combat Wing took off to bomb Rheine. Because of heavy overcast Hopsten A/D northeast of the primary was bombed visually. Good escort kept enemy fighters away but moderate and accurate flak at Rheine and the coast damaged 17 of our A/C, all of which returned to base. Our score for the day was 1-0-0.</p>
22	<p><u>Mission to Ebernburg</u>                      The 306th, led by Lt. Col. Riordan, furnished 39 A/C in two Groups for this mission and 29 A/C successfully bombed the target. First attack on the 306th came just after the target. North of Koblenz, 20 to 30 Fw190s swarmed in line abreast from 11 o'clock high, then tried to smother the formation with two more similar passes. During these attacks the Group lost 7 A/C, including Lts. Kestor, Macomber and C.K. Oliver of the 367th, Lt. Symons of the 368th, Lt. Tocabe of the 423rd and Lts. Horst and Quaintance of the 369th. Very accurate gunfire from Bonn, Aachen and Rotterdam, damaging 23 of our A/C. Several crew members were wounded on this mission, Lt. Fry of the 367th seriously. Our score for the day was 5-1-12.</p>
24	<p>Twenty A/C, led by Lt. Col. Kaper, heading the 1st Division, were airborne in a third attempt to knock out the ball bearing factory at Schweinfurt. Excellent navigation by Major Chesney enroute enabled avoidance of flak except at the target. On the way in 30 yellow nosed Me109s swarmed through the formation, coming head-on in pairs. During this encounter Lts. Garrett of the 423rd was shot down with 10 minutes observed bailing out and Page of the 367th. 17 of our A/C bombed the target, strike photos showing the target area covered with smoke. Our score for the day was 2-0-1.</p>
25	<p>Nineteen A/C, led by Capt. Kitt, were airborne on mission to Augsburg, and 13 A/C bombed the primary with good results. Course was south of briefed route going in and Group received some very accurate flak from Saarbrucken, followed immediately by two attacks out of the sun by Me109s. The Group lost Lts. Coleman and Gay of the 368th on this attack and fifteen minutes later lost a third A/C, Lt. Bayless, also of the 368th to enemy fighters. Our score for the day was 3-0-0.</p>
28	<p>Another "quickie" on a Mobell in the Pas de Calais area. Twenty-four A/C took off led by Capt. R.B. Thompson of the 423rd. Due to cloud cover the lead Squadron failed to pick up the primary and returned to base with their bombs. Two other squadrons of 17 A/C bombed target #106 with good results as confirmed by strike photos. Fighter opposition was nil and flak moderate however, 7 of our A/C sustained battle damage because of coming too close to Rouan.</p>

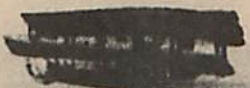
