DAY	EVENT
Sept. 2	Adj. John S. Chalfant and Maurice V. Salada received their promotions to Lt. Col. They are C.O.'s of the 423rd and 368th squadrons, respectively.
3	LUDWIGSHAFEN, GERMANY - The 306th group flew 36 A/C of the 40th "B" group led by Captain Kestling. The target was in the I.G. Farbenindustrie area with two aiming points chosen. As the target was completely covered by clouds the PFF aiming point in the southern part of the area was hit. Plank was moderate at the target and this group encountered no trouble. Advantage was taken of the greater part of France that the Allies now hold and the route went over Paris. Through a break in the clouds most of the fellows were able to get a good view of the city.
5	LUDWIGSHAFEN, GERMANY - Again the target was the heart of the German chemical industry. The 306th led the division in with Colonel G.L. Robinson flying in the lead ship of the 40 "A" group of which we provided 36 A/C. The run was PFF and the Mickey sets were not working very well. A few poor strikes were observed.
8	LUDWIGSHAFEN, GERMANY - For the third raid in a row the night of the Eighth AAF was thrown at this town and its industry. Major Flannagan led the 36 A/C of the 40th "A" group on this PFF raid. Results were unobserved.
9	The entire group took the day off to celebrate its second anniversary in the ETO. A gala affair was the "order of the day" with a carnival, fights, ball games, stage shows, dances, and last but not least, free beer. Billy Conn's appearance with his troupe was of headline importance in the morning show. Also many availed themselves of the opportunity of seeing an EB 109, an FW 190 and a JU 88 which were on view near the tower. Two parts of Major Glen Miller's band were here. One was confined to a hangar where the enlisted men enjoyed a huge dance. The other outfit, featuring Mel Powell and Ray McKinley, put forth from the new "B" mess club. Women were in profusion and all appeared to have a wonderful time. Only two dark spots came across the horizon. One being that the group put up a formation the next day. The other was the suicide death of Corporal Robert M. Bicksten of the 367th. Too, the 8th AAF All-Stars added a bit of woe by trimming our station baseball team in the afternoon.
10	STUTTGART, GERMANY - Lt. Col. Riordan led the 306th a little further in today, with a good visual run. Bomb strikes are shown to be directly on the MPI. We flew 36 A/C of the 40th "B" group.
11	EISENACH-LUTZKENDORF, GERMANY - The 306th provided 36 A/C for the 40th "B" group led by Lt. Col. Salada. The primary target was Herseberg but the Mickey operators were unable to pick up returns on their equipment and no bombs were dropped. The lead and high squadrons made a run on the secondary at Eisenach with excellent results achieved. The low dropped its bombs at Lutzendorf. Lt. J.F. Michosky of the 368th was last seen in the target area with his #3 engine on fire. No further reports have been received. Fighter attacks were seen on both the wings, ahead and behind.

12	<p>RUHLAND, GERMANY - The 306th had on this day its most unsuccessful raid since their ill-fated trip to Munich on April 24th. We put up 36 A/C of the 40th "A" group. The route carried us around Berlin from the north. As we came by the North side of the town we came a little close to Cronienburg. Their flak got into our formation and almost at the same time another group in a vain effort to clear themselves, slid through our formation which split us even more. At this juncture about 25 FW190s dove through the group taking a number of planes. We lost three in the flak and five more to the fighters. Lts. M.R. Barr of the 367th and J.W. Sasser of the 306th and Major R.H. Farwell of the 368th were seen to be hit by flak. Chutes were seen from each and the planes went down in flames. Lts. C.C. Wegener, P.F. Bailey, and L.J. White of the 367th and D.W. Gates and M.W. Freeman of the 423rd were knocked down by the fighters. Chutes are believed to have come from all planes. The high and low squadrons bore the brunt of this attack and were considerably scattered by the time our escort drove off the bandits. Then, the two groups formed on Lt. G.L. Donkin on the east side of Berlin. Soon however, Lt. Donkin was forced to leave the formation because of the condition of his plane and Lt. L.W. Gasman took over the lead. The group then proceeded to the target area where they dropped their bombs. The target was visual and was a part of the huge oil reserves of the Reich. Lt. Col. Chaifant was leading the group. One E/A was destroyed by Sgt. J.H. Hoffman of the 368th. Lt. Donkin crash landed his plane near Manston. Of his crew, S/Sgt. J.B. Eppler was killed by a 20 mm. shell and Captain A.C. Hostettler was killed in the crash. Lt. Donkin, Lt. G.A. Weiler, T/Sgts. W.H. Colvin and C.D. Tuers were injured. Sgt. J.F. Bonen and S/Sgt. H.C. West of the 423rd were injured. Two days after this raid Lt. Sasser received his promotion to captaincy.</p>
13	<p>MERCEBURG, GERMANY - The 306th group flew 24 A/C as the high squadrons of the 40th "A" and "B" groups in the continued attack of this synthetic oil plant. Capt. Hanson and Lt. McKee led the squadrons and the results were unobserved. Capts. Witt and Golladay received their Majorities.</p>
17	<p>VOLKEL, HOLLAND - Again the heavies were called upon to give direct support to the ground troops. We provided 34 A/C of the 40th "B". Bombing was done by 6 six ship sections. 3 of the 4 assigned MFI's were solidly hit by this attack from 15,000 feet. Sections were led by Lts. Couris, Gasman, Peterson, Alyea, Dodge, and Evans. Lt. Wag-enfehr and Sgt. Christenson of the 367th were wounded by flak.</p>
19	<p>UNNA, GERMANY - On what appeared to be a bad day, 24 A/C of the field flew as the 40th "A" group in a heavy attack on Hitler's ordnance stores at Unna, which is just beyond the Ruhr Valley. Major Cille led the group and good hits were observed. Due to intense clouds over the base, all A/C were ordered to land on the East coast. Only six managed to return to the field and the remainder landed at Halesworth.</p>
22	<p>KASSEL, GERMANY - Again we provided 24 A/C as the high squadrons of the 40th "A" and "B" groups. A PFF run was made on the town over 10/10 clouds. Our squadrons were led by Lts. Dodge and McKee.</p>
23	<p>On this date the 306th group received its fifth Commanding Officer since its inception. Colonel James S. Sutton of the 40th CGW took over the command from Colonel George L. Robinson who has been ordered home.</p>

25	FRANKFURT, GERMANY - After the devastating losses of the 12th, the 306th finally was able to put up an entire group of 36 A/C which flew as the 40th "B" group, led by Captain Kesling. Again the weather dictated a PFF run on the town.
27	COLOGNE, GERMANY - For the first time in its history, the 306th group went into the flak of the third largest city in the Reich. Lt. Col. Riordan led the 36 A/C of the 40th "A" group. A PFF run was made and Captain Hiblack took over on the bomb run due to failure of the load equipment. A few breaks in the clouds disclose the load and high bombs to the west and the low in the city itself. Lt. J.J. Davis of the 367th was forced to crash land his plane in France.
28	MAGDEBURG, GERMANY - 35 A/C of the 306th group flying as the 40th "B" and 6 A/C of the 40th "C" attacked this city with poor results shown. Lt. Col. Salada led the 40th "B" group. Lt. R.L. Cardon of the 367th was forced to bail his crew out near Brussels and then he and his co-pilot crash landed the plane. Sgts. L.E. Smith and Sgt. E. Schneider of the 367th were wounded.
29	Lt. Col. Robert P. Riordan was relieved of command of the 369th squadron and was transferred out of the group, to take over the position of air executive officer of the 92nd group.
30	MUNSTER, GERMANY - The 306th flew 24 A/C of the 40th "A" group which led the 1st Bombardment Division. A very good PFF run was made on the center of the city. Lt. Col. W.S. Raper led the group. Major Cheney and Major Coons flew with him. Captain E.W. Kesling, 367th ops officer was promoted to Major.
