
Dear Russ:


I must of got lost somewhere along the way. My name is in the Directroy but with an old address in Iowa City, Iowa.

Dear W. C.,

It was good to hear from you again and to get you reinstated on the mailing list for the 306th. A new directory is in progress and should be along towards the end of the month. Now you will be included.

In checking your card in my file, I note that you arrived very early with the 306th. By any chance, do you have a list of men who came along then, or can you put together any kind of a list? It probably would be helpful in dating the arrival of other men at that time for whom I do not have a firm date.

I am presently expending some effort in trying to improve the files that I have. I am presently retyping the 3x5 cards, reordering information and making corrections where I see errors. I expect to be involved in this over the next couple of years.

You said Jack Boyle showed you the last Echoes. Here are a couple of other copies you probably missed along the way.

We have placed our Kalamazoo house on the market and expect to be moving back to the Carolinas sometime late spring or early summer. We will live in the Charlotte area, where we spent 10-12 years prior to 1979, when we came back to our hometown, Kalamazoo. I retired in January, and so am devoting more of my time to 306th efforts.
