HIGHLIGHTS OF MILITARY SERVICE:

The experience of being a team member on nineteen combat missions was the high point of my military career. As a crew member flying in a B-24 from Bangor, Maine, to Greenland, to Island and on to England was a chilling experience due to poor weather conditions. Following V.E. Day in England I was chosen to attend Shrivenhm University for an eight week course. Those credits plus a correspondence course earned one semester of college credit. The sight of the Statue of Liberty in New York City harbor on January 4, 1946, after a long sea trip, from France to the U.S. and my discharge on January 10, 1946, also were highlights of my military experience.

As an 18 year old in October, 1943 I joined the Army Air Force and was activated in February, 1944. My military history included Basic Training, Gunnery School and Flight Crew Training. Our crew flew a B-24 bomber to England in November, 1944. We were assigned to the 306th Bomb Group and the 368 Bomb Squadron. Our first mission over Germany was on December 28th, 1944. I flew 19 missions as a waist or tail gunner from February, 1945, through to the end of the war in Europe.
