TO : Commanding Officer, 306th Bombardment Group (H)

1. Leader of 40th "B" with 36 A/C of 306th main group climbed to 20,000' over England to get above weather. Was convinced other CBW leaders had done same thing. In target area, he heard other Combat Wings below him at 15,000' discussing second runs on target. Could not drop bombs for fear of hitting friendly formations below. Did not find alternate target on way out due to solid cloud cover. 306th also flew 12 A/C with 40th "C". These brought bombs back, as lead group did not drop and CBW leader was only A/C with GH equipment.

3. Weather
Clouds much worse and higher than briefed over England, 5/10 with bases 14,000 to tops 20,000. Built up to 10/10 over continent, tops 19,000 to 20,000 feet.

4. Aircraft Returning Early
A/C 943-L, pilot Krzyston, turned back at 5045N-0015E at 0639 hrs., unable to find formation in clouds. Brought back 18 x 250.
A/C 086-Q, pilot Johns, lost formation in clouds and turned back at 5038N-0025E at 0645. Brought back 18 x 250.
A/C 181-B, pilot Buttorff, turned at 5002N-0032E at 0645, after losing formation in clouds. Dropped 1 delayed action bomb in Wash and returned 17 x 250.
A/C 850-B, pilot Weiland and A/C 396-H, pilot Baxter, flying spares, turned back as briefed at 0642 and 0648 respectively. Each returned 18 x 250.
A/C 153-V, pilot McKinney, flying spare, filled in when 086-Q turned back.

Summary of all that was reported about our planes firing at a B-17 heading into the formation.

A/C 836-P, pilot Mitchell, reported that just after turning back a B-17 with an H or a G in triangle came toward formation and went under it. Other planes fired at it. We did not fire. It went by to about five o'clock, then turned and came towards us, then was lost sight of.

A/C # 323-M, pilot Beswell, says a B-17 with G or H in triangle, "no markings" coming head on, was fired at from 400 yards by our bombardier. It passed underneath at 50 yards, and joined Group formation to the right. Saw it, with low group for five minutes. Camouflaged brown. Think that nose was solid no plexiglass or painted, looked different. Just before this, Foxhole Yellow called for fighter support. Bombardier fired about 40 bursts; ball turret about 50 bursts. This happened at 0742 hours, 15,000 feet.

a/c # 619-B, pilot Dreslin, stated that B-17 that was fired at had "B" in a trail

A/C # 327-U, pilot Jones, : B-17 with B in triangle, came out of clouds from south head on. When fired on by other crews dove under formation. #4 engine was smoking on approach.

A/C # 796-D, pilot Nash, : B-17 with B in triangle came head on towards formation NW
Reuch. No chin turret, closed waist window. White stripes on wing " Beat-up ship
Under this formation and joined other formation as tail end Charlie".

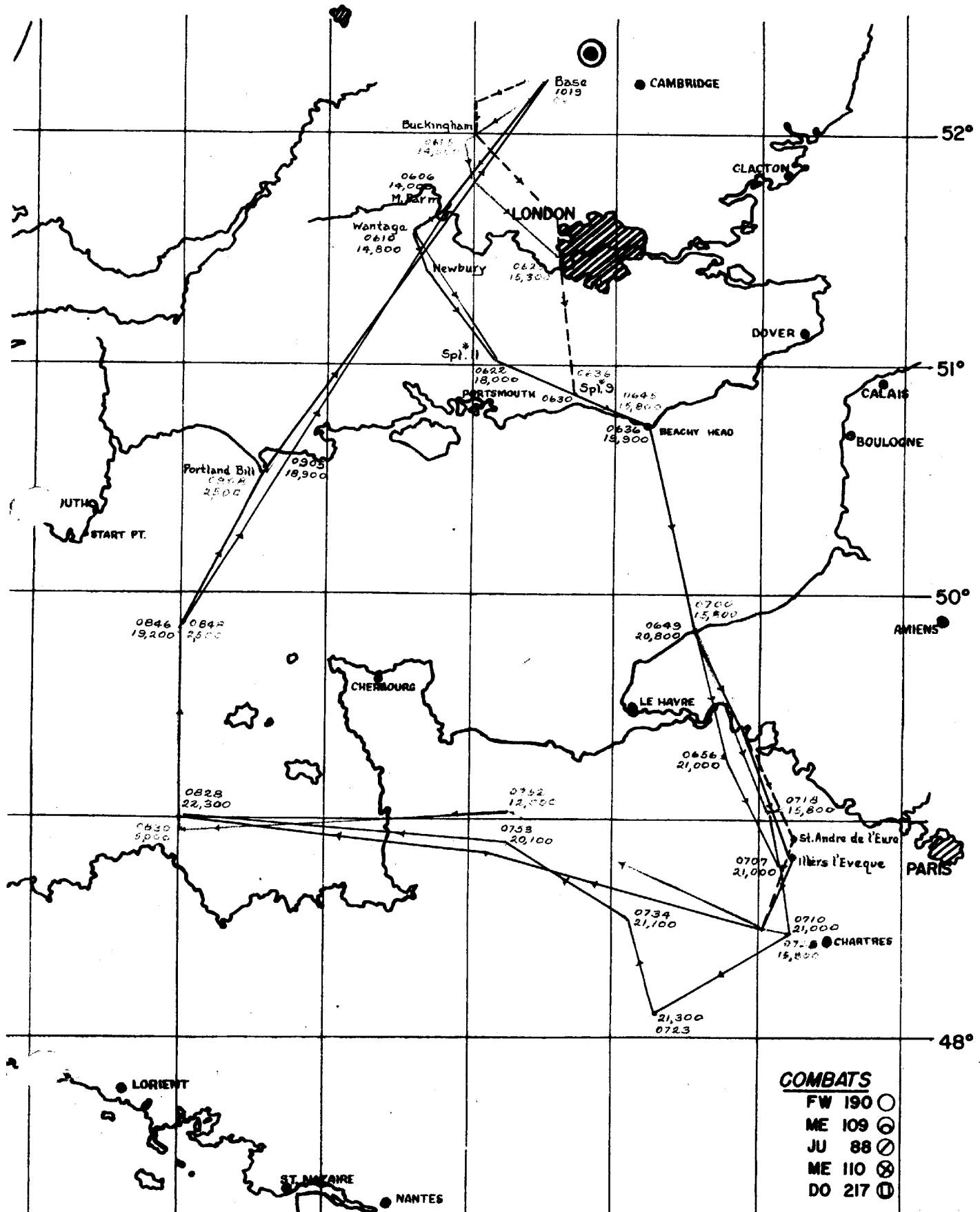
TRACK CHART

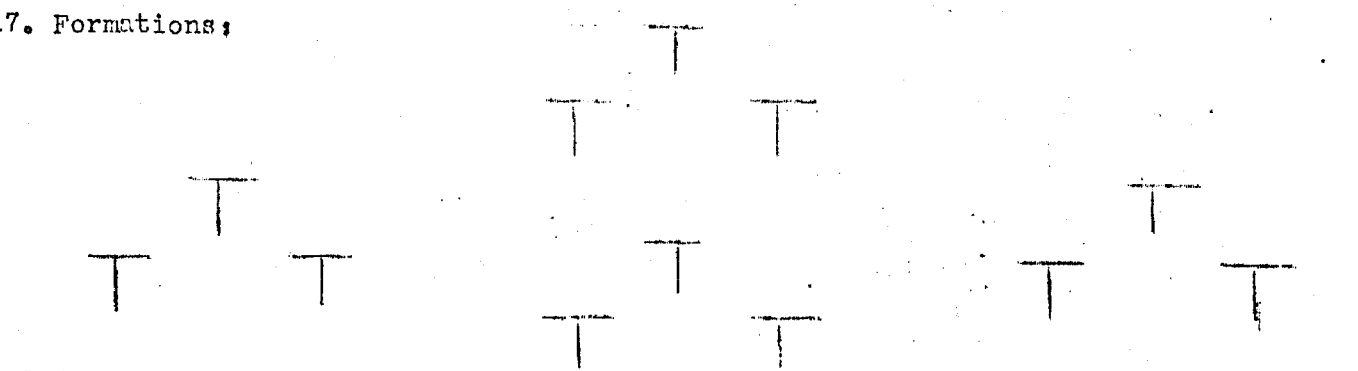

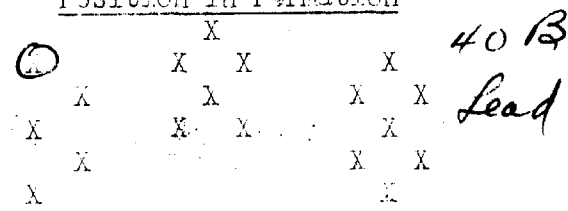

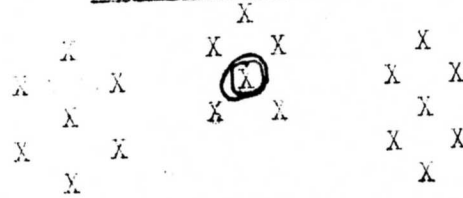
