SUBJECT: Intelligence Narrative
Mission: Noball Targets

TO : Commanding Officer, 306th Bombardment Group (H)

1. Narrative

306th Group flew lead, high and low groups of 40th "C" CBW with eighteen A/C in each group. Lead and low groups flew approximately briefed route, passed over target, could not bomb, returned. High group, observing 10/10ths cloud, turned back at IP at 0950, flew down Channel to Dungeness and then to base.

2. Fighter Opposition

No fighter opposition encountered.

3. A.A. Gun Fire

Lead Group - 4 to 6 bursts from A/D (estimated) at Coxyde (en route in). Accurate. Wing lead ship hit in tail - damage severe. Tail gunner struck lightly - not injured.

Low and High Groups: None

4. Bombing

52 A/C brought bombs back. 2 A/C jettisoned as follows:

A/C 578, pilot Wood, 24 x 100 (booby) at 2 miles SSW Folkestone 7,000 feet, 1025 hours. Saw them hit water.

A/C 180, pilot Baldwin, 12 x 500, at 5122N - 0215E, 0957½ hours. (heading 360° mag.)

5. Weather

10/10ths at 10,000 feet over Continent and Channel. Also cirrus from 22,000 to 30,000 feet.

6. A/C Returning Early

A/C 616, pilot Winward, turned back at 0855 at 5145N - 0005W. Oxygen system out. Returned 12 x 500.

A/C 503, pilot Miller, turned back at 0820 at Splasher 10 due to illness of pilot. Returned 12 x 500.
