

The 2020 & 2021 reunions of our 306th BGHA will be held TWO DIFFERENT WAYS to better evaluate the best "fit" for us

2020 Memphis TN in conjunction with the reunion of the 8th Air Force Historical Society (www.8thafhs.org) to be held from Weds Oct 21 to Sunday Oct 25. The 6-pages of 2020 reunion-info available below include:

- **Hotel reservation information** including **CAUTION TO RESERVE YOUR ROOM PROMPTLY** (*We know at some earlier 8thAFHS reunions, some attendees had to stay at other hotels, if they had not reserved rooms at the chosen reunion hotel before all reservations available were taken*); pre- and post-reunion days at the group-rate; info re wheelchair rentals; room cancellation policy up to 48 hours ahead without penalty.

NOTE that a limited number of Hospitality Suites can be reserved by groups at NO charge (these Hospitality Suites are in close proximity to each other & "most are large enough for two or more groups to share space." In Savannah our speakers said some Friday night Rendezvous Dinners are held for those groups within their Hospitality Suite).

- **Reunion Registration Instructions**, again with a caution to reserve your room first;

- **Reunion Schedule** includes Weds evening 6-7pm complimentary Welcome Reception; Weds dinner on your own; complimentary breakfast Thurs thru Sun mornings; reasonably-priced dinners Thurs, Fri, & Sat; Hospitality Suites open Weds "7pm until ... Hospitality Suites remain open throughout reunion"

- **Reunion Registration Form**: **NOTE IMPORTANT FYIs re first few lines**: *Top line on the Reunion Registration Form is "DUES: The principal attendee MUST be a member of the 8th AFHS to register for this reunion. If you are NOT a CURRENT member, please pay your yearly dues \$40 here." We were told in Savannah by our reunion speakers, that one yearly 8thAFHS DUES Membership fee covers those listed on that Reunion Registration form. The next 2 lines are 8thAFHS Reunion Registration Fee of \$45 (which appears to be per adult) & \$30 per "children ages 8-16 attending more than 1 function & staying at hotel."*

- **Tours on Thurs, Fri, & Sat**

2021 Tucson AZ our reunion will be held in conjunction with one or two other WWII Bomb Group organizations. Tucson is served by numerous airlines, including Southwest Airlines and Alaska Airlines. It is home of the Pima Air & Space Museum, one of the world's largest non-government funded aerospace museums, displaying a B-17 and much more, in its vast 127-acre campus. The Museum offers bus tours of the "Boneyard" of US aircraft not in service, which is adjacent to the Museum at Davis-Monthan Air Force Base. Davis-Monthan is an active US Air Force Base, host unit of which is the 355th Wing.
